- Carderock stone can be incorporated into all phases of a project. In a community, for example, entrance walls or piers can greet guests or prospective buyers, parapet walls or retaining walls can define landscape designs, and specimen boulders can be the focal point of landscapes. The builder who uses Carderock stone for stone skirts, housefronts, or fireplaces can carry on these themes. In towncenter or cityscape designs, planters and tree wells are easily constructed using Carderock stone. For groundcover and dry stream bed applications, Carderocks™, a tumbled product, gives a smooth river stone appearance in the same beautiful color range.
- Carderock® Drywall Stone: a rough and somewhat flat wallstone for dry and semi-dry applications greater than 3-ft. in height. Gives a rustic appearance.
- Carderock® Garden Wall Stone: smaller and flatter than the drywall stone with most stones having one good face. Ideal for dry stack walls up to 3-ft.-high. Easy to install.
- Carderock® Veneer Stone: used anywhere a 4-in. to 6-in. veneer stone is required. Installation styles include dry impression, random rustic, roughly squared, or ashlar.
- Carderock® Landscape Boulders: stones varying size or shape to be used as specimens or accents.
- Carderock® Flagging: rustic flagging used for stepping stones, water features, or coping.
- Carderocks™: for groundcover and dry streambed applications, this tumbled product has the smooth texture of a river stone with the distinctive color range of Carderock stone.

Features

Carderock stone is a quartzite/mica schist building stone available in six different grades with a color range from tan to chocolate brown, light gray to brilliant blue and blue-green. This broad range of color and texture allow it to be incorporated into almost any landscape design. Unaffected by freeze/thaw cycles, this durable natural stone can be used in applications involving direct water contact such as ponds, waterfalls, and other water features. Three different grades of wallstone allow for wall designs from raised garden beds of 1-ft. or less to sitting walls to retaining walls of 10-ft. or more.
